3 options for transferring materials between libraries.

6 library automation are current logistical challenges; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the State Library, On-line Dakota Information Network, the Department of

8 Public Instruction, the State Board of Higher Education, the North Dakota Library Association,

9 and the Central Dakota Library Network understand the need for an updated automation of

10 State Library data to track items owned, orders made, bills paid, and patrons who have

11 borrowed;

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF

13 NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

14 That the Legislative Management study the automation of State Library data as used to

- 15 track items owned, orders made, bills paid, patrons who have borrowed, and options for
- 16 transferring materials between libraries; and

17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Management report its findings and

18 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to

19 the Sixty-fifth Legislative Assembly.
