1	A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Management to consider studying issues of
2	fairness and equity as they relate to child support guidelines and the obligor model.
3	WHEREAS, North Dakota law provides both parents have a mutual duty to support a child
4	of the parents; and
5	WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of a child to be supported emotionally, physically, and
6	financially by both parents, regardless of the marital status of the parents; and
7	WHEREAS, more than a quarter of the children in North Dakota live in single-parent
8	households; and
9	WHEREAS, concerns have been expressed the child support guidelines do not adequately
0	recognize child support caps and as a result some child support payments are excessive and
11	result in providing support to the obligee instead of to the child; and
2	WHEREAS, concerns have been expressed there are inequities in the child support
3	guidelines and child support obligor model as they relate to children and obligors; and
4	WHEREAS, although the Legislative Management has studied the issue of child support
5	guidelines and the obligor model in the past, including during the 1991-92, 1997-98, and
6	2009-10 interims, these studies have not adequately addressed these concerns regarding the
7	child support guidelines and child support model;
8	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
9	NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
20	That the Legislative Management consider studying issues of fairness and equity as they
21	relate to child support guidelines and the obligor model; and
22	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Management report its findings and
23	recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
