- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the highway patrol;
- 2 to provide a report; and to provide for a transfer.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds 5 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and 7 other income, to the highway patrol for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the highway 8 patrol, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023, as follows: 9 Adjustments or 10 Base Level Enhancements Appropriation 11 Highway patrol <u>\$59,586,945</u> \$29,685,283 \$89,272,228 12 Total all funds \$59,586,945 \$29,685,283 \$89,272,228 13 28,486,064 Less estimated income 15,373,370 43,859,434 14 Total general fund \$44,213,575 \$1,199,219 \$45,412,794

6 The 2021-23 biennium one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget 7 for the 2023-25 biennium. The highway patrol shall report to the appropriations committees of 8 the sixty-eighth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium

9 beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023.

10 SECTION 3. ESTIMATED INCOME - TRANSFER - HIGHWAY TAX DISTRIBUTION FUND.

The estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$8,538,213, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, from the state highway tax distribution fund which may be transferred at the direction of the superintendent of the highway patrol for defraying the expenses of the highway patrol during the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending

15 June 30, 2023.

16 SECTION 4. ESTIMATED INCOME - MOTOR CARRIER ELECTRONIC PERMIT

17 TRANSACTION FUND. The estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes

18 \$1,706,450 from the motor carrier electronic permit transaction fund for defraying various

expenses associated with the issuance of permits and other nonenforcement motor carrier andadministrative activities.

21 SECTION 5. ESTIMATED INCOME - STRATEGIC INVESTMENT AND IMPROVEMENTS

FUND. The estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$27,100,000,
or so much of the sum as may be necessary, from the strategic investment and improvements

24 fund for the law enforcement training academy building project.

SECTION 6. PAYMENTS TO HIGHWAY PATROL OFFICERS. Each patrol officer of the state highway patrol is entitled to receive from funds appropriated in section 1 of this Act an amount not to exceed \$200 per month for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023. The payments are in lieu of reimbursement for meals and other expenses, except lodging, while in travel status within the state of North Dakota or while at the patrol officers' respective home stations. The amounts must be paid at the time and in the same Sixty-seventh Legislative Assembly

- 1 manner as salaries are paid to members of the highway patrol and may be paid without the
- 2 presentation of receipts or other memorandums.
