

**FIRST ENGROSSMENT
with House Amendments
ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2018**

Introduced by

Appropriations Committee

(At the request of the Governor)

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state historical
2 society.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
5 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and
7 other income, to the state historical society for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that
8 agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013, as follows:

18 The 2011-13 one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget for the
19 2013-15 biennium. The state historical society shall report to the appropriations committees of
20 the sixty-third legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium
21 beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.

22 **SECTION 3. REVOLVING FUND - APPROPRIATION.** All fees collected by the state
23 historical society and deposited in the revolving fund established pursuant to section 55-03-04
24 are appropriated to the state historical society for the purposes provided in chapter 55-03, for
25 the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.

26 **SECTION 4. GIFTS, GRANTS, AND BEQUESTS - APPROPRIATION.** All gifts, grants,
27 devises, bequests, donations, and assignments received by the state historical society and
28 deposited with the state treasurer pursuant to section 55-01-04 are appropriated to the state
29 historical society for the purposes provided in section 55-01-04, for the biennium beginning
30 July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.

- 1 **SECTION 5. STATE ONSITE PROJECT MANAGER - HERITAGE CENTER ADDITION**
2 **PROJECT.** Notwithstanding section 55-01-02.1, the director of the facility management division
3 of the office of management and budget shall serve as the state onsite project manager for the
4 heritage center addition project until completion of the project. The state onsite project manager
5 has authority to verify and approve all expenditures relating to the project and related exhibits.
