- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the North Dakota
- 2 state university extension service, northern crops institute, upper great plains transportation
- 3 institute, main research center, branch research centers, and agronomy seed farm; to provide
- 4 for a report; and to provide an exemption.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the North Dakota state university extension service, the northern crops institute, the upper great plains transportation institute, the main research center, branch research centers, and agronomy seed farm, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the North Dakota state university extension service, the northern crops institute, the upper great plains transportation institute, the main research center, branch research centers, and agronomy seed farm, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023, as follows:

The 2021-23 biennium one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget for the 2023-25 biennium. The main research center shall report to the appropriations committees of the sixty-eighth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023.

### SECTION 3. DICKINSON RESEARCH EXTENSION CENTER - MINERAL RIGHTS

**INCOME.** The Dickinson research extension center may spend up to \$755,000 of revenues received during the 2021-23 biennium from mineral royalties, leases, or easements for ongoing operational expenses. Any revenues received in excess of \$755,000 may be spent only for one-time expenditures for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023.

# SECTION 4. WILLISTON RESEARCH EXTENSION CENTER - MINERAL RIGHTS INCOME - REPORT. The Williston research extension center shall report to the sixty-eighth

legislative assembly on amounts received and spent from mineral royalties, leases, or easements in the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021, and the

30 biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023.

1 SECTION 5. ADDITIONAL INCOME - APPROPRIATION. In addition to the amount 2 included in the grand total other funds appropriation line item in section 1 of this Act, any other 3 income, including funds from federal acts, private grants, gifts, and donations, or from other 4 sources received by the North Dakota state university extension service, the northern crops 5 institute, the upper great plains transportation institute, the main research center, branch 6 research centers, and agronomy seed farm, except as otherwise provided by law, is 7 appropriated for the purpose designated in the act, grant, gift, or donation, for the biennium 8 beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023. 9 SECTION 6. ESTIMATED INCOME - STRATEGIC INVESTMENT AND IMPROVEMENTS 10 FUND - UPPER GREAT PLAINS TRANSPORTATION INSTITUTE - BRANCH RESEARCH 11 **CENTER PROJECTS.** The estimated income line item in subdivision 3 of section 1 of this Act 12 includes the sum of \$225,000 from the strategic investment and improvements fund for remote 13 sensing of infrastructure for the upper great plains transportation institute. The estimated 14 income line item in subdivision 4 of section 1 of this Act includes the total sum of \$2,073,000 15 from the strategic investment and improvements fund for capital projects at the Carrington 16 research center, central grasslands research center, Hettinger research center, and Langdon 17 research center. 18 SECTION 7. EXEMPTION - TRANSFER AUTHORITY. Notwithstanding section 54-16-04, 19 upon approval of the state board of agricultural research and education and appropriate branch 20 research center directors, the director of the office of management and budget shall transfer 21 appropriation authority within subdivisions 1, 2, 4, and 5 of section 1 of this Act. 22 SECTION 8. EXEMPTION - FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITION ADJUSTMENTS. 23 Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the state board of higher education may adjust or 24 increase full-time equivalent positions as needed for the entities in section 1 of this Act, subject 25 to availability of funds. All full-time or part-time positions must be separate from North Dakota 26 state university. Annually, the board shall report to the office of management and budget and to 27 the budget section on any adjustments made pursuant to this section. 28 SECTION 9. EXEMPTION - UNEXPENDED GENERAL FUND - EXCESS INCOME. Any 29 unexpended general fund appropriation authority available to and any excess income received 30 by entities listed in section 1 of this Act are not subject to the provisions of section 54-44.1-11, 31 and any unexpended funds from these appropriations or revenues are available and may be

1 expended by those entities, during the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2 2025. 3 **SECTION 10. EXEMPTION.** The \$500,000 of other funds appropriated for the Williston 4 research extension center greenhouse and the \$750,000 from the general fund appropriated for 5 the Williston research extension center seed cleaning plant in subdivision 4 of section 1 of 6 chapter 20 of the 2019 Session Laws and the \$1,500,000 of other funds appropriated for the 7 Williston research extension center seed cleaning plant in subdivision 5 of section 1 of 8 chapter 45 of the 2017 Session Laws continued into the 2019-21 biennium pursuant to 9 section 10 of chapter 20 of the 2019 Session Laws are not subject to the provisions of section 10 54-44.1-11, and any unexpended funds from these appropriations or related revenues are 11 available and may be expended during the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, and ending 12 June 30, 2023. 13 SECTION 11. CAPITAL PROJECTS - AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT - BUDGET 14 SECTION REPORT. During the 2021-22 interim, the director of the North Dakota state 15 university main research center shall report to the legislative management regarding priority 16 capital projects and other expenses that may be eligible for funding from the state fiscal 17 recovery fund allocated to the state under the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021.
