SENATE BILL NO. 2034 (Legislative Management) (Judiciary Committee)

AN ACT to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-66 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to written advisory opinions regarding ethics.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 54-66 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Advisory opinions - Authority - Effect.

- 1. In response to a request from a public official, candidate for elected office, or lobbyist, the ethics commission may provide a written advisory opinion regarding the application of the following to specified hypothetical facts or prospective conduct:
 - a. Article XIV of the Constitution of North Dakota; or
 - <u>b.</u> <u>State statutes and ethics commission rules related to transparency, corruption, elections, and lobbying.</u>
- 2. Within fourteen days after receiving a request for a written advisory opinion, the ethics commission shall notify the requester whether an opinion will be provided.
- 3. Within ninety days after notifying a requester that a written advisory opinion will be issued, the ethics commission shall issue the opinion.
- 4. <u>Criminal and civil penalties may not be imposed upon an individual for an action taken in accordance with an opinion issued under this section if:</u>
 - a. The individual acts in good faith; and
 - <u>b.</u> The material facts surrounding the action taken are substantially the same as the conduct presented in the opinion.
- <u>5.</u> Opinions and requests for opinions under this section are open records, except names of persons in the opinions and requests are exempt records.
- 6. The ethics commission shall publish all written advisory opinions issued under this section on a website that is accessible to the public.
