4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 43-45-01 of the North Dakota Century

- 6 1. "Addiction counseling" means the provision of counseling or assessment of
- 7 persons individuals regarding their gambling or the use or abuse of alcohol, tobacco,
- 8 <u>nicotine</u>, or a controlled other harmful substance or behavior, as defined in the
- 9 "Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders", American psychiatric
- 10 <u>association, fifth edition, text revision (2013), or a future edition adopted by the board.</u>
- 11 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 43-45-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 12 amended and reenacted as follows:

13 **43-45-06. Addiction counseling practice - Exemptions.**

- Nothing in this This chapter may be construed to does not prevent any person from doing work within the standards and ethics of that person's profession and calling, provided if that the person does not represent to the public, by title or by use of the initials L.A.C., that the person is engaging in addiction counseling.
- Nothing in thisThis chapter may be construed todoes not prevent addiction counseling
 trainees or interns in board-approved programs from engaging in addiction counseling
 related to training.
