1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the legislative branch

2 of state government; to provide for applications, transfers, and cancellation of unexpended

3 appropriations; to amend and reenact sections 54-03-20 and 54-35-10 of the North Dakota

4 Century Code, relating to legislative compensation; and to declare an emergency.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds 7 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 8 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from the insurance 9 regulatory trust fund, not otherwise appropriated, to the legislative branch of state government 10 for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that branch, for the fiscal period beginning with the 11 effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 2019, as follows:

5 SECTION 4. TRANSFERS. Notwithstanding section 54-16-05, the director of the office of 6 management and budget and the state treasurer shall make transfers of funds between line 7 items of appropriations for the legislative management and legislative council as may be 8 requested by the chairman of the legislative management or the director of the legislative 9 council upon the finding by the chairman or the director that the nature of studies and duties 10 assigned to the legislative management or legislative council requires the transfers in properly 11 carrying on the legislative management's and legislative council's functions and duties. The 12 director of the office of management and budget and the state treasurer shall similarly make 13 transfers of funds between the line items for the sixty-fifth and sixty-sixth legislative assemblies, 14 upon request by the chairman of the legislative management or the director of the legislative 15 council upon the finding by the chairman or director that the transfers are required for the 16 legislative assembly to carry on its functions and duties.

17 SECTION 5. APPLICATION, TRANSFER AUTHORITY, AND CANCELLATION OF

18 **UNEXPENDED APPROPRIATIONS.** Sections 54-16-04 and 54-44.1-11 do not apply to 19 chapter 1 of the 2015 Session Laws. The director of the office of management and budget and 20 the state treasurer shall make transfers of funds between the line items and the agencies of the 21 legislative branch within section 1 of that chapter as requested by the chairman of the legislative 22 management or the director of the legislative council. The office of management and budget 23 shall cancel unexpended appropriations for the legislative assembly and legislative council 24 enacted prior to the 2015-17 biennium as directed by the chairman of the legislative 25 management or the director of the legislative council.

SECTION 6. AMENDMENT. Section 54-03-20 of the North Dakota Century Code is
amended and reenacted as follows:

54-03-20. Compensation and expense reimbursement of members of the legislative
assembly.

Each member of the legislative assembly is entitled to receive as<u>As</u> compensation for
services the sum of one hundred seventy-seven dollars for each calendar day during

23				reduced maximum reimbursement for a single dwelling in which two or more			
24				legislators share lodging and the total rent for that dwelling exceeds the			
25				amount to which a legislator is entitled under subdivision a.			
26	3.	a.	Mer	nbers of the legislative assembly who receive reimbursement for lodging are			
27			also	entitled to reimbursement for travel for not to exceed one round trip taken			
28			duri	ng any calendar week, or portion of a week, the legislative assembly is in			
29			ses	sion, between their residences and the place of meeting of the legislative			
30			ass	embly, at the rate provided for state employees with the additional limitation			
31			that	reimbursement for travel by common carrier may be only at the cost of coach			

1			fare and may not exceed one and one-half times the amount the member would
2			be entitled to receive as mileage reimbursement for travel by motor vehicle.
3		b.	A member of the legislative assembly who does not receive reimbursement for
4			lodging and whose place of residence in the legislative district that the member
5			represents is not within the city of Bismarck is entitled to reimbursement at the
6			rate provided for state employees for necessary travel for not to exceed one
7			round trip taken per day between the residence and the place of meeting of the
8			legislative assembly when it is in session and may receive reimbursement for
9			lodging at the place of meeting of the legislative assembly as provided in section
10			44-08-04 for each calendar day for which round trip travel reimbursement is not
11			claimed, provided that the total reimbursement may not exceed the maximum
12			monthly reimbursement allowed under subdivision a of subsection 2.
13	4.	The a	amount to which each legislator is entitled must be paid following the
14		orgar	nizational session in December and each month upon submission of a voucher
15		and a	appropriate documentation during a regular or special session, consistent with
16		section	on 26 of article XI of the constitution of North Dakota.
17	5.	lf dur	ing a special session, the legislative assembly adjourns for more than three days,
18		a me	mber of the legislative assembly is entitled to receive compensation during those
19		days	only while in attendance at a standing committee if the legislator is a member of
20		that o	committee, a majority or minority leader, or a legislator who is not on that
21		comr	nittee but who has the approval of a majority or minority leader to attend.
22	6.	A day	y, or portion of a day, spent in traveling to or returning from an organizational,
23		spec	ial, or regular session or a legislative committee meeting must be included as a
24		caler	ndar day during a legislative session or as a day of a legislative committee
25		meet	ing for the purposes of this section.
26	7.	a.	In addition, each member is entitled to receive during the term for which the
27			member was elected, as compensation for the execution of public duties during
28			the biennium, the sum of four hundred ninety-five dollars a month, paid-
29			monthlythe sum of five hundred dollars each month through June 30, 2018, and
30			five hundred five dollars each month thereafter, paid monthly.

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1		b. If a member dies or resigns from office during the member's term, the me	ember
2		may be paid only the allowances provided for in this section for the perio	d for

4		c. The majority and minority leaders of the house and senate and the chair	man of
5		the legislative management, if the chairman is not a majority or minority	leader,
6		are each entitled to receive as compensation, in addition to any other	
7		compensation or expense reimbursement provided by law, the sum of th	ree
8		hundred fifty-five dollars per monththree hundred fifty-nine dollars per mo	<u>onth</u>
9		through June 30, 2018, and three hundred sixty-three dollars per month	
10		thereafter, during the biennium for their execution of public duties.

20	SEC	TION 7. AMENDMENT. Section 54-35-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is	3
21	amende	and reenacted as follows:	
22	54-3	5-10. Compensation of members and leadership.	
23	1.	The members of the legislative management and the members of any commit	ttee of
24		the legislative management are entitled to be compensated for the time spent	in
25		attendance at sessions of the legislative management and of its committees a	at the rate
26		of one hundred seventy-seven dollars per dayone hundred seventy-nine dolla	irs per
27		day through June 30, 2018, and one hundred eighty-one dollars per day there	eafter,
28		and must also be paid for expenses incurred in attending said meetings and i	n the
29		performance of their official duties in the amounts provided by law for other st	ate
30		officers.	

In addition to the compensation provided in subsection 1, the chairman of the
legislative management is entitled to receive an additional five dollars for each day
spent in attendance at sessions of the legislative management and of its committees,
and the chairman of each of the legislative management's committees is entitled to
receive five dollars for each day spent in attendance at sessions of the legislative
management or of the committee which the person chairs.
SECTION 8. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
