## **SENATE BILL NO. 2086**

- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 40-06 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to participation in city governing body meetings by residents of areas
- 3 within the extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction of the city; and to amend and reenact section
- 4 40-21-01 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to qualified electors in city elections.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 40-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 8 Extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction resident participation in deliberations of governing
- 9 **body**.
- The governing body of a city that elects to exercise extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction under
- 11 <u>section 40-47-01.1 shall appoint at least one resident of the territory subject to the</u>
- 12 <u>extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction of the city to serve as a nonvoting member of the governing</u>
- body. At the biennial organizational meeting of the governing body, the governing body shall
- 14 <u>select the representative of the extraterritorial zoning territory from individuals who submit</u>
- 15 <u>applications to serve on the governing body.</u>
- 16 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 40-21-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 17 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 18 40-21-01. Qualified electors in municipalcity election Restrictions.
- 19 Every resident of a municipalitycity and any resident of the extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction
- 20 of the city who is qualified to vote therein at general elections may vote at all municipalcity
- 21 elections held therein. When elections are held by wards or precincts, a personan individual
- 22 may not vote in any place other than the ward or precinct of which the personindividual is a
- resident, except an individual who is a resident of the extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction of the

- 1 city and entitled to vote in the ward or precinct to which that area of the jurisdiction has been
- 2 <u>designated to vote by the governing body of the city</u>.
