## **ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2100**

- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 49-02-27 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to decommissioning of solar energy conversion facilities.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 49-02-27 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

- 6 **49-02-27. Decommissioning of** windrenewable energy conversion facilities.
- The commission shall adopt rules governing the decommissioning of commercial wind
   energy conversion facilities. The rules must address:
- 9 a. The anticipated life of the project;
- 10 b. The estimated decommissioning costs in current dollars;
- c. The method and schedule for updating the costs of the decommissioning and
  restoration;
- 13 d. The method of ensuring that funds will be available for decommissioning and
  14 restoration;
- e. The anticipated manner in which the project will be decommissioned and the site
  restored; and
- 17 f. Present and future natural resource development.
- 18 2. The facility owner or operator of a commercial wind energy facility shall record the
- 19 location of any portion of underground foundation not removed during
- 20 decommissioning with the county recorder in the county in which any such
- 21 underground foundation is located.
- 3. <u>The commission may adopt rules governing the decommissioning of commercial solar</u>
   energy conversion facilities.
