1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-21-41.4 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to safety belt usage; to repeal section 39-21-41.5 of the North Dakota Century Code,

3 relating to secondary enforcement of safety belt requirements; and to provide a penalty.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-21-41.4 of the North Dakota Century Code is
6 amended and reenacted as follows:

39-21-41.4. Use of safety belts required in certain motor vehicles - Enforcement 8 Evidence.

9 Subject to the limitations of this section and section 39-21-41.5, aA driver may not operate 10 upon a highway a motor vehicle designed for carrying fewer than eleven passengers, which 11 was originally manufactured with safety belts unless each front seat occupant is wearing a 12 properly adjusted and fastened safety belt. This section does not apply to a child in a child 13 restraint or safety belt in accordance with section 39-21-41.2; to drivers of implements of 14 husbandry; to operators of farm vehicles as defined in subsection 5 of section 39-04-19; to rural 15 mail carriers while on duty delivering mail; to an occupant with a medical or physically disabling 16 condition that prevents appropriate restraint in a safety belt, if a qualified physician, physician 17 assistant, or advanced practice registered nurse states in a signed writing the nature of the 18 condition and the reason restraint is inappropriate; or when all front seat safety belts are in use 19 by other occupants. A physician, physician assistant, or advanced practice registered nurse 20 who, in good faith, provides a statement that restraint would be inappropriate is not subject to 21 civil liability. A violation for not wearing a safety belt under this section is not, in itself, evidence 22 of negligence. The fact of a violation of this section is not admissible in any proceeding other 23 than one charging the violation.

24 **SECTION 2. REPEAL.** Section 39-21-41.5 of the North Dakota Century Code is repealed.
