

**Sixty-third Legislative Assembly of North Dakota  
In Regular Session Commencing Tuesday, January 8, 2013**

SENATE BILL NO. 2134  
(Senators Lyson, Armstrong, Oehlke)  
(Representatives Hatlestad, Porter)

AN ACT to amend and reenact subsection 4 of section 65-01-15.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to definition of law enforcement officers for workforce safety and insurance purposes; to provide for application; to provide an effective date; and to declare an emergency.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 4 of section 65-01-15.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

4. For purposes of this section, "law enforcement officer" means a person who is licensed to perform peace officer law enforcement duties under chapter 12-63 and is employed full time by the bureau of criminal investigation, the game and fish department, the state highway patrol, the parole and probation division, the North Dakota state university police department, the North Dakota state college of science police department, the university of North Dakota police department, a county sheriff's department, or a city police department, or the parks and recreation department pursuant to section 55-08-04.

**SECTION 2. APPLICATION.** Section 1 of this Act applies only to injuries or conditions initially occurring on or after the effective date of this Act and to expenses related to those injuries and conditions.

**SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Act becomes effective July 1, 2013.

**SECTION 4. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
