- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-03 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the intent to refuse federal education funding tied to federal
- 3 mandates.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15.1-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
- 6 and enacted as follows:
- 7 <u>Legislative intent.</u>
- 8 It is the intent of the state that parents have the primary responsibility for the education of
- 9 the parent's children and not the federal, state, or local government. The federal government
- 10 has no authority within the Constitution of the United States to impose educational mandates on
- 11 <u>children in the state. Federal funds originate from the citizens of the several states or sources</u>
- 12 <u>from which the citizens of the several states authorize the federal government to collect.</u>
- 13 Because federal funds belong to the citizens of the several states, it is irrational and fraudulent
- 14 for the federal government to condition the return of funds to the state on compliance with
- 15 federal mandates. The state shall protect the rights of parents to exercise control over the
- 16 education of their children. The state and the schools of the state shall refuse any federal
- 17 funding conditioned on compliance with federal education mandates, conditions, or
- 18 requirements.
