- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for the development of an implementation plan for state-funded
- 2 county social services; and to provide for a report to the legislative assembly.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES - DEVELOPMENT OF AN
IMPLEMENTATION PLAN FOR STATE-FUNDED COUNTY SOCIAL SERVICES - REPORT
TO THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. During the 2017-18 interim, the department of human
services shall develop an implementation plan for the eventual state funding of county social
services and elimination of county human service levy authority under section 57-15-06.7. The
plan must be developed in consultation with an advisory committee that must include at least
four members of the legislative assembly and additional members selected by the executive
director of the department. The development of the plan may include a proposed pilot project
and must address the following items: options for efficiencies and aggregation and consolidation
of county social services offices and organizations, including the potential reduction in county
and other staff; considerations for oversight and chain of command within social services and
human services; and recommendations for caseloads and outcomes for social services,
designated child welfare services, and economic assistance. The development of the plan must
consider the delivery of county social services to ensure appropriate and adequate levels of
service continue under the structure proposed in an implementation plan. The implementation
plan must be submitted to the sixty-sixth legislative assembly as part of the department of
human services budget request and identify the estimated biennial cost of the plan upon full
implementation.
