- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 4.1-01 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to a bioscience innovation grant program; to provide a continuing
- 3 appropriation; to provide an appropriation; and to provide for a transfer.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 4.1-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 7 <u>Bioscience innovation grant program Continuing appropriation.</u>
- 8 <u>1. The agriculture commissioner shall collaborate with a local association having</u>
 9 bioscience experience to develop and administer a bioscience innovation grant
- bioscience experience to develop and administer a bioscience innovation grant
- program through the bioscience innovation grant fund.
- 11 <u>2. The commissioner shall collaborate with the committee established under</u>
- 12 <u>subsection 5 to adopt rules and criteria necessary to administer the bioscience</u>
- innovation grant program. The rules must include criteria for program eligibility.
- 14 <u>including requiring a bioscience business that receives funding through the program</u>
- match up to fifty percent of the amount of the grant received.
- 16 <u>3.</u> The bioscience innovation grant fund is a special fund created in the state treasury.
- Moneys in the fund are appropriated on a continuing basis to the commissioner to
- 18 <u>award grants to:</u>
- 19 <u>a. Support biotechnology innovation and commercialization in areas including crop</u>
- 20 genetics, biofuels, biomaterials, biosensors, and biotechnology in relation to food,
- 21 <u>nutrition, animals, humans, equipment, medical and health products and</u>
- 22 <u>services, medical diagnostics, medical therapeutics, and farm-based</u>
- 23 pharmaceuticals;

1		<u>b.</u>	Promote the creation of bioscience jobs in the state to be filled by graduates from
2			institutions under the control of the state board of higher education;
3		<u>C.</u>	Encourage the development of new bioscience technologies and bioscience
4			startup companies in the state;
5		<u>d.</u>	Leverage the agriculture industry in the state to support the development of
6			bioscience technologies impacting livestock operations and crop production;
7		<u>e.</u>	Promote bioscience research and development at institutions under the control of
8			the state board of higher education; and
9		<u>f.</u>	Encourage coordination and collaboration among other entities and programs in
0			the state to promote bioscience innovation goals.
11	<u>4.</u>	A bi	oscience business operating in the state is eligible to receive a grant under the
2		prog	gram if the business:
3		<u>a.</u>	Employs at least two employees;
4		<u>b.</u>	Has documented annual sales of less than two million five hundred thousand
5			dollars; and
6		<u>C.</u>	Is a corporation, partnership, limited liability company, limited partnership, or
7			limited liability partnership registered in the state.
8	<u>5.</u>	<u>The</u>	bioscience innovation program shall award grant funding through a committee
9		cons	sisting of:
20		<u>a.</u>	One representative from the department of agriculture appointed by the

22		<u>b.</u>	One representative from the bioscience association of North Dakota appointed by
23			the board of the bioscience association of North Dakota; and

28	SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - TRANSFER. There is appropriated out of any moneys in		
29	the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$1,000,000, or so		
30	much of the sum as may be necessary, which the director of the office of management and		
₹1	hudget shall transfer to the bioscience innovation grant fund during the biennium beginning

- 1 July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021. Of the funds provided in this section, up to \$400,000
- 2 may be awarded to entities providing assistance to develop bioscience companies.
