A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subdivision a of subsection 1 of section 40-47-01.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to extraterritorial zoning.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subdivision a of subsection 1 of section 40-47-01.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
a. A city may, by ordinance, extend the application of a city's zoning regulations to any quarter quarter section of unincorporated territory if a majority of the quarter quarter section is located within the following distance of the corporate limits of the city:
(1) OneOne-half mile [1.61.80 kilometers] if the city has a population of fewer than five thousand. A city that has exercised its authority under this subdivision has joint zoning and subdivision regulation jurisdiction from one-halfone-quarter mile [ 80.40 kilometer] to oneone-half mile [1.61.80 kilometers] with the other political subdivision.
(2) Two milesOne mile [ 3.221 .61 kilometers] if the city has a population of five thousand or more, but fewer than twenty-five thousand. A city that has exercised its authority under this subdivision has joint zoning and subdivision regulation jurisdiction from oneone-half mile [1.61.80 kilometers] to milesone mile [ 3.221 .61 kilometers] with the other political subdivision.
(3) Fourtwo miles [6.443.22 kilometers] if the city has a population of twenty-five thousand or more. A city that has exercised its authority under this subdivision has joint zoning and subdivision regulation jurisdiction from

milesone mile [ 3.221 .61 kilometers] to foutwo miles [ 6.443 .22
kilometers] with the other political subdivision.
