- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 13-04.1-02.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is

- 6 13-04.1-02.1. Entities exempted from licensing requirements.
- 7 This chapter does not apply to:

- 9 2. Credit unions:

- 13 6. State or federal agencies and their employees;
- 7. Institutions chartered by the farm credit administration;

- 9. Any other person or business regulated and licensed to lend money by the state of

- 18 10. A real estate broker, broker, or a real estate salesperson as defined in section
- 19 43-23-06.1 in the brokering of loans to assist a person in obtaining financing for real
- estate sold by the real estate broker, broker, or real estate salesperson; or
- 21 11. Any person, retail seller, or manufacturer providing lease financing for its own property
- or inventory held as a normal course of business, or to leases on any real property;
