- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15.1-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 Patriotic society Access to school and students.
- 7 <u>1. For purposes of this section, "patriotic society" means a youth group listed under</u> 8 <u>title 36, United States Code, subtitle II, part b.</u>
- The principal of a public school shall allow a representative of a patriotic society, during regular school hours and on school premises, to present information and recruit students to participate in the patriotic society. Before a representative of a patriotic society may speak with students at a public school, the representative shall notify the principal of the representative's intent to schedule a date and time to present information to students. The principal shall respond promptly to the request and
