- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact four new sections to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the creation of the North Dakota commission on higher education
- 3 funding; and to declare an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
6 and enacted as follows:

- 7 North Dakota commission on higher education funding Membership.
- 8 The North Dakota commission on higher education funding consists of:
- 91.a.The governor or an individual designated by the governor, who shall serve as the10chairman;
- 11 <u>b.</u> <u>The commissioner of higher education or the commissioner's designee;</u>
- 12 <u>c.</u> <u>Two members of the state board of higher education, selected by the state board;</u>
- 13d.The vice president for finance and administration at North Dakota state university14or the vice president's designee;
- 15e.The vice president for finance and operations at the university of North Dakota or16the vice president's designee;
- 17 <u>f.</u> One individual, appointed by the governor, who is employed as the business
 18 <u>manager or the vice president for finance at a two-year institution under the</u>
 19 <u>control of the state board of higher education;</u>
- 20g.One individual, appointed by the governor, who is employed as the business21manager or the vice president for finance at any institution under the control of22the state board of higher education other than an institution represented under
- 23 <u>subdivision d, e, or f;</u>
- 24 h. The chairman of the senate education committee or the chairman's designee;

15	SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created				
16	and enacted as follows:

19	The North Dakota commission on higher education funding shall establish its own duties				
20	and rules of operation and procedure, including rules relating to appointments, terms of office,				
21	vacancies, quorums, and meetings, provided that the duties and the rules do not conflict with				
22	this Act.				
23	SECTION 3. A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created				
24	and enacted as follows:

4	<u>3.</u>	<u>The</u>	commissioner of higher education shall use up to forty thousand dollars from			
5		mo	neys appropriated in the system governance line item in the appropriation bill for			
6		<u>the</u>	North Dakota university system office, as approved by the legislative assembly, to			
7		pro	vide the compensation and reimbursements required by this section.

11	<u>1.</u>	<u>In c</u>	rder to ensure the continued delivery and financing of a quality system of higher			
12		<u>edı</u>	cation in this state, the North Dakota commission on higher education funding shall			
13		<u>exa</u>	mine alternative methods for funding higher education, including any funding			
14		me	hod that is developed by the state board of higher education or others and which			
15		<u>will</u>	reward:			
16		<u>a.</u>	Specifically identified outcomes such as:			
17			(1) Increases in the number of degrees awarded;			
18			(2) Increases in the number of on-time graduations:			
19			(3) The number of degrees awarded to low-income students; and			
20			(4) Increases in the number of students retained beyond their first year; and			
21		<u>b.</u>	Any other outcome considered desirable by the commission.			
22	<u>2.</u>	<u>The</u>	North Dakota commission on higher education funding may:			
23		<u>a.</u>	Examine a funding methodology that is based on the actual cost of delivering a			
24			quality education to the various cost categories of enrolled students, as			
25			determined by the commission, including online students, students whose			
26			programs require laboratory access, and graduate students, as well as any other			
27			categories of students;			
28		<u>b.</u>	Develop a system of weighted student costs, one of which could include the size			
29			of the educating institution; and			
30		<u>C.</u>	Assume that historic spending levels are the initial indicator of the actual cost of			
31			educating students.

1 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
