5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 3 of section 15.1-21-01 of the North Dakota

7 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
