A BILL to provide for a legislative management study of the scope of practice and regulation of electricians.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - REGULATION OF AND SCOPE OF PRACTICE OF ELECTRICIANS. During the 2019-20 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying the regulation of and scope of practice of electricians. The study must include consideration of scope of practice and regulation as they relate to power limited systems and must include receipt of information from stakeholders, including trade groups. The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation necessary to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-seventh legislative assembly. S. B.
