- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 11-11 and a new section to
- 2 chapter 40-05 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the power of counties and
- 3 municipalities to prohibit local development by a foreign adversary; to amend and reenact
- 4 section 47-01-09 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the prohibition on ownership of
- 5 real property by a foreign adversary; and to declare an emergency.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 11-11 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
 and enacted as follows:

<u>Development by a foreign adversary - Prohibition.</u>

- 1. A board of county commissioners, including a board in a home rule county, may not procure, authorize, or approve a development agreement, building plan, or proposal relating to county development with an individual or government identified as a foreign adversary under 15 CFR 7.4(a).
- 14 2. This section does not apply to a foreign adversary defined under subsection 1
 possessing an interest in real property if the foreign adversary:
 - a. Is a duly registered business and has maintained a status of good standing with the secretary of state for seven years or longer before the effective date of this
 Act:
 - b. Has been approved by the committee for foreign direct investment in the United
 States; and
 - c. Maintains an active national security agreement with the federal government.
- SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 40-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
