A concurrent resolution requesting the Legislative Management to consider studying the
process necessary to replace the Life Skills and Transition Center in Grafton with statewide
services for individuals with disabilities.
WHEREAS, the Life Skills and Transition Center has become a safety net for individuals
with disabilities who live in areas of the state without sufficient services; and
WHEREAS, the population of the Life Skills and Transition Center has been reduced to a
number that is inefficient for the state to care for in a large institution; and
WHEREAS, the Life Skills and Transition Center employs more than four full-time
equivalent positions for each individual served; and
WHEREAS, the buildings and grounds of the Life Skills and Transition Center are not at
optimal use; and
WHEREAS, the United States Supreme Court's Olmstead decision requires states to
"place persons with mental disabilities in community settings rather than in institutions"; and
WHEREAS, community settings may prove to be a more efficient and compassionate
method of serving individuals with disabilities; and
WHEREAS, amending subsection 8 of Section 12 of Article IX of the Constitution of North
Dakota to remove the institution in Walsh County will open more options for stakeholders and
the Legislative Assembly;
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE
HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
That the Legislative Management consider studying the process necessary to replace the
