8 The Department of Correctional Services is hereby authorized to
9 complete repairs and maintenance on water system infrastructure at the
10 Nebraska State Penitentiary in Lincoln, Nebraska.

12 Sec. 113. GENERAL FUND TRANSFERS.

13 (1) The State Treasurer shall make the transfers specified in this
14 section from the General Fund to the designated fund, in the amounts
15 indicated. Unless otherwise noted, transfers for FY2023-24 shall occur on
16 July 1, 2023, or as soon thereafter as administratively possible, and
17 transfers for FY2024-25 shall occur on July 1, 2024, or as soon
18 thereafter as administratively possible. All agencies with administrative
19 responsibilities for these funds shall assist the State Treasurer as
20 needed in implementing the transfers.

21 (2) Transfers from the General Fund for FY2023-24 shall include
22 transfers to:

23 (a) The Nebraska State Patrol Cash Fund: \$115,000 less the
24 unexpended balance existing on June 30, 2023, in (i) the Nebraska State
25 Patrol Cash Fund, (ii) the Investigation Petty Cash Fund, (iii) any
26 special checking account or accounts used by the Nebraska State Patrol,

1 and (iv) the possession of agency personnel involved in investigations,
2 when the unexpended balances resulted from General Fund transfers to the
3 Nebraska State Patrol Cash Fund or from General Fund appropriations. Any
4 transfers made shall be subject to a final reconciliation of available
5 investigation cash fund balances as of June 30, 2023, by the Nebraska
6 State Patrol.

7 It is the intent of the Legislature that the Nebraska State Patrol
8 have available a total of \$115,000 from the General Fund for FY2023-24 to
9 be used in making drug purchases, for enforcing Nebraska laws relating to
10 felonies, for enforcing the Nebraska liquor laws, and for payment of
11 investigative expenses;

12 (b) The Property Tax Credit Cash Fund: \$360,000,000 on or before
13 December 15, 2023, on such date as directed by the budget administrator
14 of the budget division of the Department of Administrative Services;

15 (c) The Water Sustainability Fund: \$11,000,000 on or before June 30,
16 2024, on such date as directed by the budget administrator of the budget
17 division of the Department of Administrative Services;

18 (d) The Community College State Dependents Fund: \$1,000,000 on or
19 before July 10, 2023, on such date as directed by the budget
20 administrator of the budget division of the Department of Administrative
21 Services;

22 (e) The Economic Recovery Contingency Fund: \$10,000,000 on or before
23 June 30, 2024, on such dates and in such amounts as directed by the
24 budget administrator of the budget division of the Department of
25 Administrative Services;

26 (f) The Site and Building Development Fund: \$5,000,000 on or before
27 June 30, 2024, on such dates and in such amounts as directed by the
28 budget administrator of the budget division of the Department of
29 Administrative Services;

30 (g) The Compensation Court Cash Fund: \$750,000 on or after July 1,
31 2023, but before December 31, 2023, on such dates and in such amounts as

1 directed by the budget administrator of the budget division of the
2 Department of Administrative Services;

3 (h) The Lead Service Line Cash Fund: \$10,000,000 on or before June
4 30, 2024, on such dates and in such amounts as directed by the budget
5 administrator of the budget division of the Department of Administrative
6 Services; and

7 (i) Commission on Public Advocacy Operations Cash Fund: \$1,000,000
8 on or before December 31, 2023, on such dates and in such amounts as
9 directed by the budget administrator of the budget division of the
10 Department of Administrative Services.

11 (3) Transfers from the General Fund for FY2024-25 shall include
12 transfers to:

13 (a) The Nebraska State Patrol Cash Fund: \$115,000 less the
14 unexpended balance existing on June 30, 2024, in (i) the Nebraska State
15 Patrol Cash Fund, (ii) the Investigation Petty Cash Fund, (iii) any
16 special checking account or accounts used by the Nebraska State Patrol,
17 and (iv) the possession of agency personnel involved in investigations,
18 when the unexpended balances resulted from General Fund transfers to the
19 Nebraska State Patrol Cash Fund or from General Fund appropriations. Any
20 transfers made shall be subject to a final reconciliation of available
21 investigation cash fund balances as of June 30, 2024, by the Nebraska
22 State Patrol.

23 It is the intent of the Legislature that the Nebraska State Patrol
24 have available a total of \$115,000 from the General Fund for FY2024-25 to
25 be used in making drug purchases, for enforcing Nebraska laws relating to
26 felonies, for enforcing the Nebraska liquor laws, and for payment of
27 investigative expenses;

28 (b) The Property Tax Credit Cash Fund: \$395,000,000 on or before
29 December 15, 2024, on such date as directed by the budget administrator
30 of the budget division of the Department of Administrative Services;

31 (c) The Water Sustainability Fund: \$2,519,000 on or before June 30,

1 2025, on such dates and in such amounts as directed by the budget
2 administrator of the budget division of the Department of Administrative
3 Services;

4 (d) The Economic Recovery Contingency Fund: \$40,000,000 on or before
5 June 30, 2025, on such dates and in such amounts as directed by the
6 budget administrator of the budget division of the Department of
7 Administrative Services;~~and~~

8 (e) Commission on Public Advocacy Operations Cash Fund: \$1,000,000
9 on or before December 31, 2024, on such dates and in such amounts as
10 directed by the budget administrator of the budget division of the
11 Department of Administrative Services; and -

12 (f) The Nebraska Capital Construction Fund: \$10,000,000 on or before
13 June 30, 2025, on such dates and in such amounts as directed by the
14 budget administrator of the budget division of the Department of
15 Administrative Services.
