Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 762 would create the Nebraska Teacher Apprenticeship Program and would authorize the Department of Education to administer it.

Explanation of amendments:

AM 1399

Amendment 1399 provides three thousand dollars per semester for qualified participants towards education expenses such as tuition, books, and other required materials. One million dollars annually shall transfer from the Education Future Fund to the Paraprofessional to Teacher Program Fund for the purposes of this program.
