**Introducer's Statement of Intent**

**LB955**

**Committee: Banking, Commerce and Insurance**

**Date of Hearing: February 01, 2022**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 955 would make it unlawful to:

- decline or limit coverage for life, disability or long-term care insurance;
- preclude a person from donating all or part of an organ as a condition of receiving life, disability or long-term care insurance;
- consider the status of a person as a living organ donor in determining rates for coverage; and
- otherwise discriminate against a person under any life, disability, or long-term care insurance policy based solely upon the status of such person as a living organ donor.

Violation of this act shall be an unfair trade practice in the business of insurance, subject to the Unfair Insurance Trade Practices Act.
