1 Section 1. Section 33-110, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 33-110 County clerks shall receive no fee for the
- 4 performance of the following services: For issuing certificates of
- 5 election; for performing the duties of clerk of the county board; for
- 6 taking acknowledgments of claims against the county; for attesting or
- 7 certifying any document authorized by the county board or required by
- 8 the departments of the state; or for recording Army or Navy
- 9 discharges or furnishing certified copies thereof to be used in
- 10 connection with any claim for compensation or disability. A charge of
- 11 twenty-five cents shall be made for any other certificate and seal
- 12 unless otherwise provided. The fees collected shall be credited to
- 13 the county general fund.
- 14 County clerks shall receive a fee of fifteen thirty
- 15 dollars for the entire proceedings of issuing a marriage license,
- 16 administering the related oaths or affirmations, and recording a
- 17 marriage certificate. An additional fee of <u>five_seven_dollars</u> shall
- 18 be made for each certified copy of a marriage record on file in the
- 19 office of the county clerk. Both such fees shall be deposited in the
- 20 county general fund.
