- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Cash Reserve Fund; to amend section
- 2 84-612, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2021; to provide and eliminate
- fund transfer provisions; to repeal the original section; and to
- 4 declare an emergency.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 84-612, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2021, is

- 2 amended to read:
- 3 84-612 (1) There is hereby created within the state treasury a fund
- 4 known as the Cash Reserve Fund which shall be under the direction of the
- 5 State Treasurer. The fund shall only be used pursuant to this section.
- 6 (2) The State Treasurer shall transfer funds from the Cash Reserve
- 7 Fund to the General Fund upon certification by the Director of
- 8 Administrative Services that the current cash balance in the General Fund
- 9 is inadequate to meet current obligations. Such certification shall
- 10 include the dollar amount to be transferred. Any transfers made pursuant
- 11 to this subsection shall be reversed upon notification by the Director of
- 12 Administrative Services that sufficient funds are available.
- 13 (3) In addition to receiving transfers from other funds, the Cash
- 14 Reserve Fund shall receive federal funds received by the State of
- 15 Nebraska for undesignated general government purposes, federal revenue
- 16 sharing, or general fiscal relief of the state.
- 17 (4) The State Treasurer shall transfer fifty-four million seven
- 18 hundred thousand dollars on or after July 1, 2019, but before June 15,
- 19 2021, from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Nebraska Capital Construction
- 20 Fund on such dates and in such amounts as directed by the budget
- 21 administrator of the budget division of the Department of Administrative
- 22 Services.
- 23 <u>(5) The State Treasurer shall transfer one hundred seventy-five</u>
- 24 million dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Nebraska Capital
- 25 Construction Fund on or after July 1, 2022, but before June 15, 2023, on
- 26 <u>such dates and in such amounts as directed by the budget administrator of</u>
- 27 the budget division of the Department of Administrative Services.
- 28 (6) The State Treasurer shall transfer four hundred million dollars
- 29 from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Perkins County Canal Project Fund on or
- 30 before June 30, 2023, on such dates and in such amounts as directed by
- 31 the budget administrator of the budget division of the Department of

- 1 Administrative Services.
- 2 (7) No (5) The State Treasurer shall transfer thirty million dollars
- 3 from the Cash Reserve Fund to the General Fund after November 15, 2020,
- 4 but before December 31, 2020, on such date as directed by the budget
- 5 administrator of the budget division of the Department of Administrative
- 6 Services. Except for the transfer authorized in this subsection, no funds
- 7 shall be transferred from the Cash Reserve Fund to fulfill the
- 8 obligations created under the Nebraska Property Tax Incentive Act unless
- 9 the balance in the Cash Reserve Fund after such transfer will be at least
- 10 equal to five hundred million dollars.
- 11 <u>(8)</u> The State Treasurer shall transfer <u>five</u> <u>fifty</u> million
- 12 dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the United States Space Command
- 13 Headquarters Assistance Fund on or before June 30, 2023, but not before
- 14 July 1, 2022, on such dates and in such amounts as directed by the budget
- 15 administrator of the budget division of the Department of Administrative
- 16 Services. The transfer in this subsection shall not occur unless the
- 17 State of Nebraska is selected as the site of the United States Space
- 18 Command headquarters.
- 19 Sec. 2. Original section 84-612, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2021,
- 20 is repealed.
- 21 Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 22 passed and approved according to law.
