## A BILL

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$90,000 from

- 2 the General Fund and \$90,000 from the Nebraska Coordinated School
- 3 Health Fund for FY2012-13 and (2) \$90,000 from the General Fund and
- 4 \$90,000 from the Nebraska Coordinated School Health Fund for
- 5 FY2013-14 to the State Department of Education, for Program 158, to
- 6 aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 1020, One
- 7 <u>Hundred Second Legislature, Second Session, 2012.</u>
- 8 There is included in the amount shown in this section
- 9 \$90,000 General Funds and \$90,000 Cash Funds for FY2012-13 and
- 10 \$90,000 General Funds and \$90,000 Cash Funds for FY2013-14 as aid for
- 11 grants pursuant to the Nebraska Coordinated School Health Act.
- 12 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$10,000 from the
- 13 General Fund and \$10,000 from the Nebraska Coordinated School Health
- 14 Fund for FY2012-13 and (2) \$10,000 from the General Fund and \$10,000
- 15 <u>from the Nebraska Coordinated School Health Fund for FY2013-14 to the</u>
- 16 State Department of Education, for Program 25, to aid in carrying out
- 17 the provisions of Legislative Bill 1020, One Hundred Second
- 18 <u>Legislature</u>, <u>Second Session</u>, 2012.
- 19 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries
- 20 and per diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not
- 21 <u>exceed \$20,000 for FY2012-13 or \$20,000 for FY2013-14.</u>
- 22 Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
- 23 when passed and approved according to law.
