## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 1022**

Introduced by Friesen, 34. Read first time January 13, 2022 Committee:

A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; to amend section 60-4,115,
 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change provisions relating
 to fee remittance for the 24/7 sobriety program permit; and to
 repeal the original section.
 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 60-4,115, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,
 is amended to read:

3 60-4,115 (1) Fees for operators' licenses and state identification cards shall be collected by department personnel or the county treasurer 4 and distributed according to the table in subsection (2) of this section, 5 except for the ignition interlock permit and associated fees as outlined 6 in subsection (4) of this section and the 24/7 sobriety program permit 7 and associated fees as outlined in subsection (5) of this section. County 8 9 officials shall remit the county portion of the fees collected to the county treasurer for placement in the county general fund. All other fees 10 collected shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the 11 appropriate fund. 12

 14 amounts apply for operators' licenses and state identification cards.

(3) If the department issues an operator's license or a state
identification card and collects the fees, the department shall remit the
county portion of the fees to the State Treasurer for credit to the
Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund.

(4)(a) The fee for an ignition interlock permit shall be forty-five
dollars. Five dollars of the fee shall be remitted to the State Treasurer
for credit to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund. Forty dollars
of the fee shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the

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1 Department of Motor Vehicles Ignition Interlock Fund.

2 (b) The fee for a replacement ignition interlock permit shall be 3 eleven dollars. Two dollars and seventy-five cents of the fee shall be 4 remitted to the county treasurer for credit to the county general fund. 5 Six dollars of the fee shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for 6 credit to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund. Two dollars and 7 twenty-five cents of the fee shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for 8 credit to the General Fund.

9 (c) The fee for adding, changing, or removing a class, endorsement, 10 or restriction on an ignition interlock permit shall be five dollars. The 11 fee shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Department 12 of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund.

(5)(a) The fee for a 24/7 sobriety program permit shall be fortyfive dollars. Twenty-five dollars of the fee shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund. Fifteen dollars of the fee shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the General Fund. Five dollars of the fee shall be remitted to the <u>county treasurer</u> <del>State Treasurer</del> for credit to the county general fund of the participant's county of residence.

(b) The fee for a replacement 24/7 sobriety program permit shall be eleven dollars. Two dollars and seventy-five cents of the fee shall be remitted to the county treasurer for credit to the county general fund—of the participant's county of residence. Six dollars of the fee shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund. Two dollars and twenty-five cents of the fee shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the General Fund.

(c) The fee for adding, changing, or removing a class, endorsement,
or restriction on a 24/7 sobriety program permit shall be five dollars.
The fee shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the
Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund.

31 (6) The department and its agents may collect an identity security

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1 surcharge to cover the cost of security and technology practices used to protect the identity of applicants for and holders of operators' licenses 2 and state identification cards and to reduce identity theft, fraud, and 3 forgery and counterfeiting of such licenses and cards to the maximum 4 extent possible. The surcharge shall be in addition to all other required 5 fees for operators' licenses and state identification cards. The amount 6 of the surcharge shall be determined by the department. The surcharge 7 8 shall not exceed eight dollars. The surcharge shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund. 9 Original section 60-4,115, Reissue Revised Statutes of 10 Sec. 2.
