A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Public Accountancy Act; to amend
 section 1-136.02, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2014; to
 change experience requirements; and to repeal the original section.
 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 1-136.02, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
 2014, is amended to read:

3 1-136.02 (1) The board shall issue a permit under subdivision (1)(a)
4 of section 1-136 to a holder of a certificate as a certified public
5 accountant when such holder has had:

6 (a) Two years of accounting experience satisfactory to the board, in 7 any state, in employment as an accountant in <u>government</u>, a firm, 8 proprietorship, partnership, corporation, limited liability company, or 9 other business entity authorized in any state to engage in the practice 10 of public accountancy under the supervision of an active certified public 11 accountant who is the holder of a permit issued under subdivision (1)(a) 12 of section 1-136 or the equivalent issued by another state; or

13 (b) Three years of accounting experience satisfactory to the board, in any state, in employment as (i) an accountant in government or 14 business under the supervision of an active certified public accountant 15 who is the holder of a permit issued under subdivision (1)(a) of section 16 1-136 or the equivalent issued by another state or (ii) faculty at a 17 college or university of recognized standing under the supervision of an 18 active certified public accountant who is the holder of a permit issued 19 under subdivision (1)(a) of section 1-136 or the equivalent issued by 20 another state. 21

(2) The board shall issue a permit under subdivision (1)(a) of
section 1-136 to a holder of a reciprocal certificate issued under
section 1-124 upon a showing that:

(a) He or she meets all current requirements in this state forissuance of a permit at the time the application is made; and

(b) At the time of the application for a permit the applicant,
within the ten years immediately preceding application, meets the
experience requirement in subdivision (1)(a) or (b) of this section.
