- 1 Section 1. Section 24-1004, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 24-1004 The Supreme Court shall provide by rule for the preservation
- 4 of all records and of all exhibits offered or received in evidence in the
- 5 trial of any action. When the records of the district court do not show
- 6 any unfinished matter pending in the action, a judge of the district
- 7 court if satisfied they are no longer valuable for any purpose may, upon
- 8 such notice as the judge may direct, order the destruction, return, or
- 9 other disposition of such exhibits as the judge he deems appropriate when
- 10 approval is given by the State Records Administrator pursuant to the
- 11 Records Management Act sections 84-1201 to 84-1220.
- 12 Sec. 2. Section 24-1005, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 13 amended to read:
- 14 24-1005 The clerk of any district court or of any other court of
- 15 record may <u>maintain</u> <del>microfilm</del> any court record<u>as a preservation</u>
- 16 duplicate in the manner provided in section 84-1208. The original record
- 17 may be destroyed only with the approval of the State Records
- 18 Administrator pursuant to the Records Management Act sections 84-1201 to
- 19 84-1220. The reproduction of the preservation duplicate microfilm shall
- 20 be admissible as evidence in any court of record in the State of
- 21 Nebraska.
- 22 Sec. 3. Original sections 24-1004 and 24-1005, Reissue Revised
- 23 Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
