- 4 commissioners on any question shall be by roll call vote. The record
- 5 shall state how each commissioner voted or that the commissioner was
- 6 <u>absent or the commissioner did not vote.</u>
- 7 (2) When two only of the commissioners of the board shall
- 8 attend, and  $\frac{\text{shall be}}{\text{are}}$  divided on any question, the decision
- 9 thereof shall be deferred until the next meeting of the board, and
- 10 then the matter shall be decided by a majority of the board.
