A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to county boards; to amend section 23-155,  
2 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to require a record  
3 vote by roll call for action by the county board in  
4 certain counties; and to repeal the original section.  
5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1                   Section 1. Section 23-155, Reissue Revised Statutes of  
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3                   23-155 (1) Any action taken by the county board of  
4 commissioners on any question shall be by roll call vote. The record  
5 shall state how each commissioner voted or that the commissioner was  
6 absent or the commissioner did not vote.

7                   (2) When two only of the commissioners of the board ~~shall~~  
8 attend, and ~~shall be~~ are divided on any question, the decision  
9 thereof shall be deferred until the next meeting of the board, and  
10 then the matter shall be decided by a majority of the board.

11                   Sec. 2. Original section 23-155, Reissue Revised Statutes  
12 of Nebraska, is repealed.
