# A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to special education; to create and provide

  duties for the Medicaid in the Public Schools Task Force;

  to provide duties; to provide a termination date; and to

  declare an emergency.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1 Section 1. The Medicaid in the Public Schools Task Force

- 2 is created. Members of the task force shall be appointed on or before
- 3 May 1, 2012, and shall include:
- 4 (1) The chairperson of the Education Committee of the
- 5 Legislature and one other member of the committee, appointed by the
- 6 Executive Board of the Legislative Council;
- 7 (2) The chairperson of the Health and Human Services
- 8 Committee of the Legislature and one other member of the committee,
- 9 appointed by the Executive Board of the Legislative Council;
- 10 <u>(3) The chairperson of the Appropriations Committee of</u>
- 11 the Legislature and one other member of the committee, appointed by
- 12 <u>the Executive Board of the Legislative Council;</u>
- 13 (4) Two representatives of the State Department of
- 14 Education who work with special education, including one
- 15 representative who works specifically with special education funding;
- 16 (5) Two representatives of the Department of Health and
- 17 Human Services, including one representative who works specifically
- 18 with medicaid reimbursements for special education services;
- 19 (6) One representative of a consortium of school
- 20 districts that submits administrative claims for medicaid
- 21 reimbursement and that has at least one member that is a Class IV or
- 22 Class V school district;
- 23 (7) One representative of a consortium of school
- 24 districts that submits administrative claims for medicaid
- 25 reimbursement and that has at least one member that is a school

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- 1 district with fewer than three hundred ninety students;
- 2 (8) One school board member or school administrator
- 3 representing a district with more than nine hundred students;
- 4 (9) One school board member or school administrator
- 5 representing a district with more than three hundred ninety students
- 6 and fewer than nine hundred students; and
- 7 (10) In addition to the member appointed pursuant to
- 8 <u>subdivision (7) of this section, one school board member or school</u>
- 9 administrator representing a district with fewer than three hundred
- 10 <u>ninety students</u>.
- 11 The members listed in subdivision (4) of this section
- 12 <u>shall</u> be appointed by the Commissioner of Education. The members
- 13 listed in subdivisions (5) through (10) of this section shall be
- 14 appointed by the Governor.
- The chairperson of the Education Committee of the
- 16 Legislature shall be the chairperson of the task force and shall call
- 17 the initial and subsequent meetings of the task force. Members of the
- 18 task force shall be reimbursed for their actual and necessary
- 19 expenses incurred in carrying out their duties as members of the task
- 20 force as provided in sections 81-1174 to 81-1177. The Education
- 21 Committee of the Legislature, the Health and Human Services Committee
- 22 of the Legislature, the Department of Health and Human Services, and
- 23 the Legislative Fiscal Analyst shall provide research and
- 24 <u>administrative support for the task force. For budgetary purposes</u>
- 25 only, the task force shall be within the Legislative Council.

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- 1 The task force shall terminate on December 31, 2012.
- 2 Sec. 2. The Medicaid in the Public Schools Task Force
- 3 <u>shall examine:</u>
- 4 (1) The efficiency and effectiveness of the current
- 5 systems for seeking medicaid reimbursements from the federal
- 6 government for physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech
- 7 therapy, and administrative claims; and
- 8 (2) The feasibility of expanding the special education
- 9 services for which medicaid reimbursements from the federal
- 10 government are sought.
- 11 <u>In response to such examination, the task force shall</u>
- 12 make any recommendations it determines to be appropriate and shall
- 13 report such recommendations to the Education Committee of the
- 14 Legislature, the Clerk of the Legislature, and the Governor on or
- before December 31, 2012.
- 16 Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
- 17 when passed and approved according to law.
