Section 4-114, Reissue Revised Statutes of 2 Nebraska, is amended to read: 3 4-114 (1) For purposes of this section: 4 (a) Employer means all employers subject to the Nebraska 5 Workers' Compensation Act as provided in section 48-106; and 6 (a) (b) Federal immigration verification system means the 7 electronic verification of the work authorization program of the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996, 8 8 U.S.C. 1324a, known as the E-Verify Program, or an equivalent 9 federal program designated by the United States Department of 10 Homeland Security or other federal agency authorized to verify the 11 12 work eligibility status of a newly hired employee pursuant to the 13 Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986. \div 14 (b) Public contractor means any contractor or his or her 15 subcontractor who is awarded a contract by a public employer for the 16 physical performance of services within the State of Nebraska; and 17 (c) Public employer means any agency or political subdivision of the State of Nebraska. 18 19 (2) Every public employer and public contractor shall 20 register with and use a federal immigration verification system to 21 determine the work eligibility status of new employees physically performing services within the State of Nebraska. Every contract 22 between a public an employer and public contractor the employer's 23 24 employees shall contain a provision requiring the public contractor employer to use a federal immigration verification system to 25

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determine the work eligibility status of new employees physically 1 2 performing services within the State of Nebraska. 3 (3) For two years after October 1, 2009, the The 4 Department of Labor shall make available to all private employers 5 information regarding the use of the federal immigration verification б system. and encouraging the use of the federal immigration 7 verification system. The department shall report to the Legislature 8 no later than December 1, 2011, on the use of a federal immigration 9 verification system by Nebraska employers. 10 (4) This section does not apply to contracts awarded by a 11 public employer prior to October 1, 2009. 12 (4) An employer who violates this section is guilty of a 13 Class III misdemeanor. 14 Sec. 2.
