- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska State Insurance Program; to
- 2 amend sections 84-1607, 84-1608, and 84-1609, Reissue Revised
- 3 Statutes of Nebraska; to require coverage for in vitro fertilization
- 4 as prescribed; to harmonize provisions; to repeal the original
- 5 sections; and to declare an emergency.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 84-1607, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 84-1607 (1) The group life insurance contract or contracts may
- 4 permit the extension of special benefits, such as accidental death and
- 5 dismemberment benefits, amounts of life insurance in addition to the
- 6 amount provided in section 84-1605, and the extension of coverage to
- 7 dependents. Any coverage under this section shall be borne solely by the
- 8 employee.
- 9 (2) The special coverages permitted by this section shall be made
- 10 available uniformly to all employees, but each employee shall retain the
- 11 option to choose the special coverage or coverages which he or she
- 12 <u>desires or to reject all such special coverages.</u>
- 13 Sec. 2. Section 84-1608, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 14 amended to read:
- 15 84-1608 (1) The group health insurance contract or contracts may
- 16 permit the extension of special benefits, such as insurance over and
- 17 above that provided by the basic coverage specified in section 84-1605,
- 18 dental health insurance, disability insurance, accidental death and
- 19 dismemberment benefits, disability income replacement benefits, and the
- 20 extension of coverage to dependents. Any coverage under this section may
- 21 be borne solely by the employee.
- 22 (2) The special coverages permitted by this section shall be made
- 23 <u>available uniformly to all employees, but each employee shall retain the</u>
- 24 option to choose the special coverage or coverages which he or she
- 25 desires or to reject all such special coverages.
- Sec. 3. Section 84-1609, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 27 amended to read:
- 28 84-1609 (1) Beginning July 1, 2024, the Nebraska State Insurance
- 29 <u>Program shall include coverage for in vitro fertilization.</u>
- 30 (2) In providing the coverage required under subsection (1) of this
- 31 section, the program may:

- 1 (a) Limit coverage to a lifetime maximum benefit of four completed
- 2 egg retrievals;
- 3 (b) Limit coverage to those individuals who have been unable to
- 4 conceive or produce conception or sustain a successful pregnancy through
- 5 less expensive and medically viable infertility treatment or procedures
- 6 covered under the program, except that nothing in this subdivision shall
- 7 be construed to deny the coverage required by this section to any
- 8 individual who foregoes a particular infertility treatment or procedure
- 9 if the individual's physician determines that such treatment or procedure
- 10 is likely to be unsuccessful; and
- 11 <u>(c) Require that covered treatment or procedures be performed at</u>
- 12 facilities that conform to the standards and guidelines developed by the
- 13 American Society for Reproductive Medicine or the Society for
- 14 Reproductive Endocrinology and Infertility.
- 15 The special coverages permitted by sections 84-1607 and 84-1608
- 16 shall be made available uniformly to all employees, but each employee
- 17 shall retain the option to choose the special coverage or coverages which
- 18 he or she desires or to reject all such special coverages.
- 19 Sec. 4. Original sections 84-1607, 84-1608, and 84-1609, Reissue
- 20 Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
- 21 Sec. 5. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 22 passed and approved according to law.
