## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 1085**

Introduced by Pansing Brooks, 28; Hilkemann, 4; McDonnell, 5; Wayne, 13. Read first time January 18, 2022 Committee:

- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate federal
  funds to the State Department of Education; to declare legislative
  intent to appropriate funds; and to declare an emergency.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. (1) The Legislature hereby finds and declares that:
2	(a) The COVID-19 public health emergency greatly impacted Nebraska's
3	young people, resulting in lost instructional time for students, lost
4	opportunities to conduct fundraising events, and lost educational
5	<u>capacity;</u>
6	(b) There is a dire workforce need for health-science professionals,
7	educators, skilled tradespeople, and support in related fields caused by
8	the COVID-19 public health emergency; and
9	(c) Support for career and technical education programs as an
10	extension of the classroom for real-world learning experience in middle
11	and high schools is critical.
12	(2) There is hereby appropriated \$5,000,000 from Federal Funds for
13	FY2022-23 to the State Department of Education for the purpose of
14	carrying out the Center for Student Leadership and Expanded Learning Act
15	and for career and technical educational student organizations. The
16	Federal Funds appropriated in this section are from the funds allocated
17	to the State of Nebraska from the federal Coronavirus State Fiscal
18	Recovery Fund pursuant to the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021,
19	<u>Public Law 117-2, Subtitle M, Sec. 9901.</u>
20	(3) It is the intent of the Legislature:
21	<u>(a) To appropriate \$1,300,000 from the General Fund each fiscal year</u>
22	beginning in FY2022-23 for administration of the Center for Student
23	Leadership and Expanded Learning Act; and
24	(b) That expenditures may be made from such future appropriations
25	for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems for state employees.
26	Sec. 2. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
27	passed and approved according to law.
