- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds to aid
- 2 in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 1087, One Hundred
- 3 Eighth Legislature, Second Session, 2024.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$17,500,000 from the
2 Hospital Quality Assurance and Access Assessment Fund for FY2024-25 and
3 (2) \$17,500,000 from the Hospital Quality Assurance and Access Assessment
4 Fund for FY2025-26 to the Department of Health and Human Services, for
5 Program 33, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill
6 1087, One Hundred Eighth Legislature, Second Session, 2024.

7 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per
8 diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$1,000,000
9 for FY2024-25 or \$1,000,000 for FY2025-26.

10 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$632,500,000 from the
11 Hospital Quality Assurance and Access Assessment Fund and \$1,450,000,000
12 from federal funds for FY2024-25 and (2) \$632,500,000 from the Hospital
13 Quality Assurance and Access Assessment Fund and \$1,450,000,000 from
14 federal funds for FY2025-26 to the Department of Health and Human
15 Services, for Program 348, to aid in carrying out the provisions of
16 Legislative Bill 1087, One Hundred Eighth Legislature, Second Session,
17 2024.

18 There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2024-25
19 \$632,500,000 Cash Funds and \$1,450,000,000 federal funds for state aid,
20 which shall only be used for such purpose. There is included in the
21 appropriation to this program for FY2025-26 \$632,500,000 Cash Funds and
22 \$1,450,000,000 federal funds for state aid, which shall only be used for
23 such purpose.

24 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems
25 for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this
26 section.
