- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to labor; to amend section 48-1205, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section 48-1203, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2015; to change the minimum wage for persons compensated by way of gratuities; to change provisions relating to the posting
- of information; to repeal the original sections; and to declare an
- 6 emergency.
- 7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 48-1203, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2015, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 48-1203 (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section and section
- 4 48-1203.01, every employer shall pay to each of his or her employees a
- 5 minimum wage of:
- 6 (a) Seven dollars and twenty-five cents per hour through December
- 7 31, 2014;
- 8 (b) Eight dollars per hour on and after January 1, 2015, through
- 9 December 31, 2015; and
- (c) Nine dollars per hour on and after January 1, 2016.
- 11 (2)(a) For persons compensated by way of gratuities such as
- 12 waitresses, waiters, hotel bellhops, porters, and shoeshine persons, the
- 13 employer shall pay <u>cash</u> wages at the minimum rate <u>provided in subdivision</u>
- 14 (2)(b) of this section of two dollars and thirteen cents per hour, plus
- 15 all gratuities given to them for services rendered.
- 16 (b) The minimum cash wage per hour shall be:
- 17 (i) For wages paid prior to August 1, 2016, two dollars and thirteen
- 18 <u>cents per hour;</u>
- 19 <u>(ii) For wages paid on or after August 1, 2016, and before January</u>
- 20 <u>1, 2017, a wage equal to forty percent of the minimum wage rate in effect</u>
- 21 <u>under subsection (1) of this section; and</u>
- 22 (iii) For wages paid on or after January 1, 2017, a wage equal to
- 23 <u>fifty percent of the minimum wage rate in effect under subsection (1) of</u>
- 24 this section.
- 25 (c) The sum of <u>cash</u> wages and gratuities received by each person
- 26 compensated by way of gratuities shall equal or exceed the minimum wage
- 27 rate provided in subsection (1) of this section. In determining whether
- 28 or not the individual is compensated by way of gratuities, the burden of
- 29 proof shall be upon the employer.
- 30 (3) Any employer employing student-learners as part of a bona fide
- 31 vocational training program shall pay such student-learners' wages at a

- 1 rate of at least seventy-five percent of the minimum wage rate which
- 2 would otherwise be applicable.
- 3 Sec. 2. Section 48-1205, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 4 amended to read:
- 5 48-1205 Every employer subject to the <u>Wage and Hour Act</u> provisions
- 6 of sections 48-1201 to 48-1209 shall keep a summary of the act sections
- 7 48-1201 to 48-1209, furnished by the Commissioner of Labor without
- 8 charge, posted in a conspicuous place on or about the premises wherein
- 9 any person subject to the act provisions of sections 48-1201 to 48-1209
- 10 is employed. Minimum wage amounts in effect shall also be posted by such
- 11 employers and shall be furnished by the commissioner without charge.
- 12 Sec. 3. Original section 48-1205, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 13 Nebraska, and section 48-1203, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2015, are
- 14 repealed.
- 15 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 16 passed and approved according to law.
