1	A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to schools; to amend section 79-813, Reissue
2	Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide for issuance of a temporary
3	certificate or permit to the spouse of a military member based on
4	reciprocity as prescribed; to repeal the original section; and to
5	declare an emergency.

6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 79-813, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is 1 2 amended to read: 79-813 (1) The board may authorize the issuance of certificates or 3 permits to applicants who hold a valid certificate or permit currently in 4 force in a state other than Nebraska if the requirements for the 5 certificate or permit held by the applicant are comparable and equivalent 6 7 to those required for a similar type of certificate or permit issued under sections 79-806 to 79-815. 8 9 (2)(a) The board shall issue a temporary certificate or permit to a 10 military spouse who complies with and meets the requirements of this subsection pending issuance of the certificate or permit under subsection 11 12 (1) of this section. (b) A military spouse shall submit the following with his or her 13 application for the certificate or permit under subsection (1) of this 14 15 section: (i) A copy of his or her military dependent identification card 16 17 which identifies him or her as the spouse of an active duty member of the 18 United States Armed Forces; (ii) A copy of his or her spouse's military orders reflecting an 19 20 active-duty assignment in Nebraska; (iii) A copy of his or her certificate or permit from another 21 22 jurisdiction and the applicable statutes, rules, and regulations 23 governing the certificate or permit; (iv) A copy of his or her fingerprints for a criminal background 24 25 check if required under section 79-808; and (v) The fee required for the certificate or permit and the temporary 26 certificate or permit under section 79-810. 27 28 (c) If the board determines that the applicant is a resident of Nebraska, is the spouse of an active duty member of the United States 29 30 Armed Forces who is assigned to a duty station in Nebraska, holds a valid certificate or permit in another jurisdiction which has comparable and 31

1 equivalent requirements for the certificate or permit, has submitted fingerprints for a criminal background check if required under section 2 79-808, and has paid the applicable fee, the board shall issue a 3 temporary certificate or permit to the applicant. 4 (d) A temporary certificate or permit issued under this subsection 5 shall be valid for six months and may not be renewed. 6 7 Original section 79-813, Reissue Revised Statutes of Sec. 2. 8 Nebraska, is repealed.

9 Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when 10 passed and approved according to law.
