- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Animal Health and Disease Control Act;
- 2 to amend section 54-2949, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to
- 3 change provisions relating to premises registration and animal
- 4 disease traceability; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the
- 5 original section.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 54-2949, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 54-2949 (1) The department may cooperate with the Animal and Plant
- 4 Health Inspection Service of the United States Department of Agriculture
- 5 and any other local, state, or national agency or organization, public or
- 6 private, to facilitate voluntary participation in or compliance with
- 7 animal disease traceability, including animal identification and premises
- 8 <u>registration</u>. For purposes of animal disease traceability, a Nebraska
- 9 livestock owner may choose to identify animals using any method set forth
- in 9 C.F.R. part 86, as such part existed on January 1, 2020, as well as
- 11 <u>any additional method approved by the department as an official form of</u>
- 12 identification.
- 13 (2) Except if in conflict with any applicable disease traceability
- 14 or disease program requirement, the department shall (a) facilitate a
- 15 request by a registrant for withdrawal of a premises registration, (b)
- 16 cooperate with the United States Department of Agriculture as necessary
- 17 for such purpose, and (c) if such registration is withdrawn, provide
- 18 written confirmation to the registrant of the removal of premises
- 19 registration records from any department database.
- 20 (3) (1) Any information that a person provides to the department for
- 21 purposes of voluntary participation in or compliance with premises
- 22 registration, animal identification, or other components of for voluntary
- 23 participation in or compliance with animal disease traceability shall not
- 24 be a public record subject to disclosure under sections 84-712 to
- 25 84-712.09. The department and its employees or agents shall not disclose
- 26 such information to any other person or agency, except when such
- 27 disclosure: is (a) is authorized by the person who provided the
- 28 information; or (b) $\pm s$ necessary for purposes of disease surveillance or
- 29 to carry out epidemiological investigations related to incidences of
- 30 animal disease.
- 31 (4) (2) The department may disclose information as authorized by

- 1 this section subject to any confidentiality requirements that the
- 2 department determines are appropriate under the circumstances.
- 3 (5) (3) Any person who violates this section shall be subject to
- 4 prosecution for official misconduct pursuant to section 28-924.
- 5 (6) (4) Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit the
- 6 department from discussing, reporting, or otherwise disclosing the
- 7 progress or results of disease surveillance activities or epidemiological
- 8 investigations related to incidence of animal disease.
