# A BILL

1	FOR AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; to amend sections 60-3,104 and
2	60-3,130.04, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and
3	section 60-301, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2011; to
4	provide for Beef State license plates; to harmonize
5	provisions; and to repeal the original sections.
6	Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 60-301, Revised Statutes Supplement,

- 2 2011, is amended to read:
- 3 60-301 Sections 60-301 to 60-3,222 <u>and sections 2 and 3</u>
- 4 of this act shall be known and may be cited as the Motor Vehicle
- 5 Registration Act.
- 6 Sec. 2. (1) Beginning January 1, 2013, a person may apply
- 7 for Beef State license plates in lieu of regular license plates on an
- 8 application prescribed and provided by the department for any motor
- 9 <u>vehicle</u>, <u>trailer</u>, <u>semitrailer</u>, <u>or cabin trailer</u>, <u>except for motor</u>
- 10 vehicles or trailers registered under section 60-3,198. An applicant
- 11 receiving a Beef State license plate for a farm truck with a gross
- 12 weight of over sixteen tons or for a commercial motor vehicle
- 13 registered for a gross weight of five tons or over shall affix the
- 14 appropriate tonnage decal to the plate. The department shall make
- 15 forms available for such applications. Each application for initial
- 16 issuance or renewal of Beef State license plates shall be accompanied
- 17 by a fee of seventy dollars. Fees collected pursuant to this
- 18 subsection shall be remitted to the State Treasurer. The State
- 19 Treasurer shall credit fifteen percent of the fee for initial
- 20 issuance and renewal of Beef State license plates to the Department
- 21 of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund and eighty-five percent of the fee to the
- 22 <u>Highway Trust Fund.</u>
- 23 (2) When the department receives an application for Beef
- 24 State license plates, it shall deliver the plates to the county
- 25 treasurer of the county in which the motor vehicle, trailer,

1 semitrailer, or cabin trailer is registered. The county treasurer

- 2 shall issue Beef State license plates in lieu of regular license
- 3 plates when the applicant complies with the other provisions of law
- 4 for registration of the motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, or cabin
- 5 trailer. If Beef State license plates are lost, stolen, or mutilated,
- 6 the licensee shall be issued replacement license plates pursuant to
- 7 section 60-3,157.
- 8 (3)(a) The owner of a motor vehicle, trailer,
- 9 semitrailer, or cabin trailer bearing Beef State license plates may
- 10 make application to the county treasurer to have such Beef State
- 11 license plates transferred to a motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer,
- 12 or cabin trailer other than the motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer,
- 13 or cabin trailer for which such plates were originally purchased if
- 14 such motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, or cabin trailer is owned
- by the owner of the Beef State license plates.
- 16 (b) The owner may have the unused portion of the Beef
- 17 State license plate fee credited to the other motor vehicle, trailer,
- 18 semitrailer, or cabin trailer which will bear the Beef State license
- 19 plates at the rate of eight and one-third percent per month for each
- 20 full month left in the registration period.
- 21 (c) Application for such transfer shall be accompanied by
- 22 a fee of three dollars. Fees collected pursuant to this subsection
- 23 <u>shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Department</u>
- of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund.
- 25 Sec. 3. (1) The department, in designing Beef State

1 license plates, shall include the words The Beef State in the top

- 2 center of the license plate in white lettering on a black background.
- 3 (2) One type of Beef State license plates shall be
- 4 consecutively numbered plates. The department shall:
- 5 (a) Number the Beef State license plates consecutively
- 6 beginning with the number one, using numerals the size of which
- 7 <u>maximizes legibility; and</u>
- 8 (b) Not use a county designation or any characters other
- 9 than numbers on the Beef State license plates.
- 10 (3) One type of Beef State license plate shall be
- 11 personalized message plates. Such plates shall be issued subject to
- 12 the same conditions specified for message plates in subsection (2) of
- 13 section 60-3,118. The characters used shall consist only of letters
- 14 and numerals of the same size and design and shall comply with the
- requirements of subdivision (1)(a) of section 60-3,100. A maximum of
- 16 <u>seven characters may be used.</u>

- 10 Sec. 5. Section 60-3,130.04, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 11 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 12 60-3,130.04 (1) An owner of a historical vehicle eligible
- 13 for registration under section 60-3,130 may use a license plate or
- 14 plates designed by this state in the year corresponding to the model
- 15 year when the vehicle was manufactured in lieu of the plates designed
- 16 pursuant to section 60-3,130.03 subject to the approval of the
- 17 department. The department shall inspect the plate or plates and may
- 18 approve the plate or plates if it is determined that the model-year
- 19 license plate or plates are legible and serviceable and that the
- 20 license plate numbers do not conflict with or duplicate other numbers
- 21 assigned and in use. An original-issued license plate or plates that
- 22 have been restored to original condition may be used when approved by
- 23 the department.
- 24 (2) The department may consult with a recognized car club
- 25 in determining whether the year of the license plate or plates to be

1 used corresponds to the model year when the vehicle was manufactured.

- 2 (3) If only one license plate is used on the vehicle, the
- 3 license plate shall be placed on the rear of the vehicle. The owner
- 4 of a historical vehicle may use only one plate on the vehicle even
- 5 for years in which two license plates were issued for vehicles in
- 6 general.
- 7 (4) License plates used pursuant to this section
- 8 corresponding to the year of manufacture of the vehicle shall not be
- 9 personalized message license plates, Pearl Harbor license plates,
- 10 prisoner-of-war license plates, disabled veteran license plates,
- 11 Purple Heart license plates, amateur radio station license plates,
- 12 Nebraska Cornhusker Spirit Plates, handicapped or disabled person
- 13 license plates, or specialty license plates, or Beef State license
- 14 plates.
