## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 1096**

- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. <u>There is hereby appropriated (1) \$500,000 from the</u>
2	<u>General Fund for FY2020-21 and (2) \$500,000 from the General Fund for</u>
3	FY2021-22 to the Department of Correctional Services, for Program 214, to
4	provide grants to community-based organizations, community colleges,
5	federally recognized or state-recognized Indian tribes, or nonprofit
6	organizations that provide vocational and life skills programming and
7	services to adults and juveniles who are incarcerated, who have been
8	<u>incarcerated within the prior eighteen months, or who are serving a</u>
9	period of supervision on either probation or parole.
10	<u>It is the intent of the Legislature that grants be awarded to</u>
11	organizations that provide paid preparatory training programs, pre-
12	apprenticeship programs, or other paid training that leads directly into
13	<u>a Federal Registered Apprenticeship Program and that the grants require a</u>
14	minimum one-to-one cash or in-kind matching contribution. Unallocated
15	grant funds held by the department at the end of the fiscal year shall be

16 <u>reappropriated for the next fiscal year.</u>
