Committee:

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to state intent relating to
- 2 provider rates for behavioral health services as prescribed.
- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. The Legislature finds that:
- 2 (1) Behavioral health service providers have identified short-term
- 3 residential treatment, intensive outpatient treatment, and substance use
- 4 assessment as key services to reduce recidivism or re-offending;
- 5 (2) It must be a priority of the state to reduce populations in
- 6 correctional facilities, particularly persons with addiction to alcohol
- 7 or drugs;
- 8 (3) Facilities providing the services described in subdivision (1)
- 9 of this section have been at or over capacity for some time with interim
- 10 <u>and short-term residential facilities at or above one hundred percent of</u>
- 11 capacity for the three years preceding the effective date of this act;
- 12 <u>(4) Assessments for services are not completed prior to release</u>
- 13 which leads to additional financial and time burdens being placed upon
- 14 providers to adequately follow standardized models of assessment and
- 15 care;
- 16 (5) A study by the National Reentry Resource Center of the Council
- 17 of State Governments Justice Center of various states and their
- 18 implementation of similar programs found that treatment programs lead to
- 19 <u>reductions in recidivism by nearly twenty percent and reductions in those</u>
- 20 on probation from returning to prison by as much as fifty percent over a
- 21 <u>short time period; and</u>
- 22 (6) By investing in the services described in subdivision (1) of
- 23 this section, the State of Nebraska can ensure that treatment is
- 24 available in Nebraska communities.
- 25 Sec. 2. There is included in the appropriation to Agency No. 25,
- 26 <u>for Program No. 348, \$XX General Funds for FY2018-19 to provide for a</u>
- 27 provider rate increase of five percent for providers of short-term
- 28 residential treatment services, intensive outpatient treatment services,
- 29 <u>and substance use assessment services.</u>
- 30 Sec. 3. There is included in the appropriation to Agency No. 5, for
- 31 Program No. 67, \$XX General Funds for FY2018-19 to provide for a provider

- 1 rate increase of five percent for providers of short-term residential
- 2 <u>treatment services</u>, <u>intensive outpatient treatment services</u>, <u>and</u>
- 3 <u>substance use assessment services.</u>
- 4 Sec. 4. There is included in the appropriation to Agency No. 25,
- 5 for Program No. 38, \$XX General Funds for FY2018-19 to provide for a
- 6 provider rate increase of five percent for providers of short-term
- 7 <u>residential treatment services, intensive outpatient treatment services,</u>
- 8 <u>and substance use assessment services.</u>
