5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. It is the intent of the Legislature to
2	appropriate an additional \$200,000 for FY2014-15 to the Nebraska
3	Power Review Board from cash funds to provide funds for a study of
4	state, regional, and national transmission infrastructure and policy
5	and future needs for transmission infrastructure and policy to serve
6	Nebraska electric consumers and utilities and generation facilities
7	in Nebraska seeking to export electricity outside of the state.
8	Sec. 2. It is the policy of the state to encourage and
9	allow opportunities for development and operation of renewable energy
10	facilities intended primarily for export from the state in a manner
11	that protects the ratepayers of consumer-owned utility systems
12	operating in the state from subsidizing the costs of such export
13	facilities through their rates and that results in economic
14	development and employment opportunities for residents and
15	communities of the state.
16	Sec. 3. The purposes of the study provided for under this
17	act shall include, but not be limited to, identification of electric
18	transmission and generation constraints and opportunities, federal
19	and state legal and regulatory requirements and practices, national
20	and regional transmission operation, national and regional
21	transmission plans and policies, national and regional markets for
22	electricity export and opportunities for and barriers to exporting
23	electricity to such markets, and economic development benefits of
24	expanded state, regional, and national transmission connections.
25	Sec. 4. The study provided for under this act shall

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1	receive input from a working group including, but not limited to,
2	five members of the Legislature appointed by the Executive Board of
3	the Legislative Council, public power districts and other Nebraska
4	electric providers, renewable energy development companies,
5	municipalities, the Southwest Power Pool, the Western Area Power
6	Administration, other transmission system owners, operators, and
7	developers, environmental interests, and other interested parties.
8	Sec. 5. <u>(1) The Nebraska Power Review Board shall submit</u>
9	a request for proposals after consultation with the members of the
10	Legislature and other members of the working group as provided for in
11	section 4 of this act.
12	(2) The Nebraska Power Review Board shall present the
13	results of the study provided for under this act to the Executive
14	Board of the Legislative Council with a copy to the Clerk of the
15	Legislature and the Governor on or before December 15, 2014. The
16	report shall be submitted electronically.
17	Sec. 6. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect

18 when passed and approved according to law.
