- 4 Supplement, 2020; to define and redefine terms; to change provisions
- 5 relating to limits on tax credits; to provide a sunset date; to
- 6 harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original sections.
- 7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1 Section 1. Section 13-201, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 3 13-201 Sections 13-201 to 13-208 and section 4 of this act shall be
- 4 known and may be cited as the Community Development Assistance Act.
- 5 Sec. 2. Section 13-203, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 6 amended to read:
- 7 13-203 For purposes of the Community Development Assistance Act,
- 8 unless the context otherwise requires:
- 9 (1) Business firm shall mean any business entity, including a
- 10 corporation, a fiduciary, a sole proprietorship, a partnership, a limited
- 11 liability company, a corporation having an election in effect under
- 12 Chapter 1, subchapter S of the Internal Revenue Code, as defined in
- 13 section 49-801.01, subject to the state income tax imposed by section
- 14 77-2715 or 77-2734.02, an insurance company paying premium or related
- 15 retaliatory taxes in this state pursuant to section 44-150 or 77-908, or
- 16 a financial institution paying the tax imposed pursuant to sections
- 17 77-3801 to 77-3807;
- 18 (2) Community services shall mean any type of the following in a
- 19 community development area: (a) Employment training; (b) human services;
- 20 (c) medical services; (d) physical facility and neighborhood development
- 21 services; (e) recreational services or activities; (f) educational
- 22 services; or (g) crime prevention activities, including, but not limited
- 23 to, (i) the instruction of any individual in the community development
- 24 area that enables him or her to acquire vocational skills, (ii)
- 25 counseling and advice, (iii) emergency services, (iv) community, youth,
- 26 day care, and senior citizen centers, (v) in-home services, (vi) home
- 27 improvement services and programs, and (vii) any legal enterprise which
- 28 aids in the prevention or reduction of crime;
- 29 (3) Department shall mean the Department of Economic Development;
- 30 (4) Director shall mean the Director of Economic Development;
- 31 (5) Community development area shall mean (a) any village, city,

- 1 county, unincorporated area of a county, or census tract which has been
- 2 designated by the department as an area of chronic economic distress<u>or</u>
- 3 (b) any economic redevelopment area within a city of the metropolitan
- 4 class;
- 5 (6) Community assistance shall mean furnishing financial assistance,
- 6 labor, material, or technical advice to aid in the physical improvement
- 7 of any part or all of a community development area;
- 8 (7) Community betterment organization shall mean (a) any
- 9 organization performing community services or offering community
- 10 assistance in a community development area and to which contributions are
- 11 tax deductible under the provisions of the Internal Revenue Service of
- 12 the United States Department of the Treasury and (b) a county, city, or
- 13 village performing community services or offering community assistance in
- 14 a community development area; and
- 15 (8) Area of chronic economic distress shall mean an area of the
- 16 state which meets any of the following conditions:
- 17 (a) An unemployment rate which exceeds the statewide average
- 18 unemployment rate;
- 19 (b) A per capita income below the statewide average per capita
- 20 income; or
- 21 (c) A population loss between the two most recent federal decennial
- 22 censuses; and -
- 23 <u>(9) Economic redevelopment area means an area in the State of</u>
- 24 <u>Nebraska in which:</u>
- 25 (a) The average rate of unemployment in the area during the period
- 26 <u>covered by the most recent federal decennial census or American Community</u>
- 27 <u>Survey 5-Year Estimate by the United States Bureau of the Census is at</u>
- 28 least one hundred fifty percent of the average rate of unemployment in
- 29 the state during the same period; and
- 30 (b) The average poverty rate in the area is twenty percent or more
- 31 for the federal census tract in the area.

- 1 Sec. 3. Section 13-208, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 2 2020, is amended to read:
- 3 13-208 The total amount of tax credit granted for programs approved
- 4 and certified under the Community Development Assistance Act by the
- 5 department for any fiscal year shall not exceed (1) three hundred fifty
- 6 thousand dollars for fiscal years prior to fiscal year 2022-23 and (2)
- 7 five million dollars for fiscal year 2022-23 and each fiscal year
- 8 <u>thereafter</u>, except that for fiscal year 2016-17, the total amount of tax
- 9 credit granted under this section shall be reduced by seventy-five
- 10 thousand dollars.
- 11 Sec. 4. <u>No tax credits shall be granted under the Community</u>
- 12 Development Assistance Act on or after July 1, 2027.
- 13 Sec. 5. Original sections 13-201 and 13-203, Reissue Revised
- 14 Statutes of Nebraska, and section 13-208, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 15 Supplement, 2020, are repealed.
