## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 1118**

Introduced by Scheer, 19. Read first time January 22, 2020 Committee:

- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to infants and juveniles; to amend section
   43-1802, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide for
   grandparent visitation; and to repeal the original section.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 43-1802, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
 amended to read:

3 43-1802 (1) A grandparent may seek visitation with his or her minor
4 grandchild if:

5

(a) The child's parent or parents are deceased;

6 (b) The marriage of the child's parents has been dissolved or 7 petition for the dissolution of such marriage has been filed, is still 8 pending, but no decree has been entered;—or

9 (c) The parents of the minor child have never been married but 10 paternity has been legally established<u>; or</u> -

<u>(d) The parents of the minor child have denied such grandparent</u>
 <u>visitation with such child.</u>

13 (2) In determining whether a grandparent shall be granted visitation, the court shall require evidence concerning the beneficial 14 nature of the relationship of the grandparent to the child. The evidence 15 may be presented by affidavit and shall demonstrate that a significant 16 17 beneficial relationship exists, or has existed in the past, between the grandparent and the child and that it would be in the best interests of 18 19 the child to allow such relationship to continue. Reasonable rights of visitation may be granted when the court determines by clear and 20 convincing evidence that there is, or has been, a significant beneficial 21 relationship between the grandparent and the child, that it is in the 22 best interests of the child that such relationship continue, and that 23 24 such visitation will not adversely interfere with the parent-child 25 relationship.

26 (3) The court may modify an order granting or denying such 27 visitation upon a showing that there has been a material change in 28 circumstances which justifies such modification and that the modification 29 would serve the best interests of the child.
