- 2 Education Reporting System Act; to amend section 48-3704, Reissue
- 3 Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change reporting requirements; and

- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 48-3704, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 48-3704 (1) The Department of Labor shall execute a memorandum of
- 4 understanding with the Nebraska Statewide Workforce and Education
- 5 Reporting System before December 31, 2020, to ensure the exchange of
- 6 available Department of Labor data throughout the prekindergarten to
- 7 postsecondary education to workforce continuum, and may utilize data and
- 8 agreements under sections 79-776, 85-110, 85-309, and 85-1511.
- 9 (2) On or before December 1, 2022, and on or before each December 1
- 10 thereafter, the Nebraska Statewide Workforce and Education Reporting
- 11 System shall issue a report electronically to the Clerk of the
- 12 <u>Legislature and the Governor. Such report shall provide an overview of</u>
- 13 research and analysis conducted, additional data needs for future
- 14 <u>analysis</u>, and <u>organizational structure and needs</u> The Nebraska Statewide
- 15 Workforce and Education Reporting System shall issue a report
- 16 electronically to the Clerk of the Legislature on or before December 1,
- 17 2021. Such report shall make recommendations on the planning and
- 18 development of the Nebraska Statewide Workforce and Education Reporting
- 19 System, including, but not limited to, additional data and stakeholder
- 20 needs and potential future funding.
- 21 Sec. 2. Original section 48-3704, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 22 Nebraska, is repealed.
