Committee:

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Department of Health and Human
- 2 Services; to provide for a needs assessment and cost analysis study
- and report on an inpatient adolescent psychiatric unit; and to
- 4 declare an emergency.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. (1) The Department of Health and Human Services shall
- 2 contract for the completion of a needs assessment and cost analysis for
- 3 the establishment of an inpatient adolescent psychiatric unit housed
- 4 within the Lincoln Regional Center. The department shall contract with an
- 5 <u>outside consultant with expertise in cost and needs analysis of health</u>
- 6 care facilities within sixty days after the effective date of this act
- 7 for the purpose of conducting such analysis.
- 8 (2) The department shall submit a report electronically to the
- 9 Health and Human Service Committee of the Legislature and the Clerk of
- 10 <u>the Legislature on or before October 15, 2020. Such report shall contain</u>
- 11 <u>the following information:</u>
- 12 <u>(a) A needs assessment, including the number of adolescents expected</u>
- 13 to use such inpatient psychiatric unit;
- 14 (b) The cost of opening an existing facility at the Lincoln Regional
- 15 Center for use as an inpatient adolescent psychiatric unit;
- 16 (c) The cost of re-opening the facility at the Lincoln Regional
- 17 Center, including the costs for necessary construction, upgrades, or
- 18 repairs;
- 19 (d) Annual operating costs of such unit, including, but not limited
- 20 to, any federal funds available to operate the unit in addition to
- 21 <u>General Fund appropriations; and</u>
- 22 (e) Cost savings realized by moving adolescents from out-of-state
- 23 institutions back to Nebraska for treatment at such unit.
- 24 (3) For purposes of this section, adolescent means a juvenile who
- 25 could be placed at a youth rehabilitation and treatment center under
- 26 <u>sections 43-251.01 and 43-286.</u>
- 27 Sec. 2. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 28 passed and approved according to law.
